

The following information is to be followed by all attendees. The courtroom is located on a military installation. All signs must be obeyed. The speed limit is 20 mph and is strictly enforced. Anyone exceeding the speed limit is subject to ticketing and the possibility of being barred from base access. All individuals must have a drivers license and drivers of private automobiles must have a statement of car insurance with them. Depending on the terrorist threat level in place, the time necessary to gain access to the installation may take up to 30 minutes. Therefore, all attendees should arrive no later than 8:45 a.m.
